

Electric coops send technical support to Pangasinan to help restore power

The Philippine Rural Electric Cooperatives Association, Inc. (PHILRECA) and the National Electrification Administration (NEA) deployed lineworkers to help in power restoration efforts of the Pangasinan I Electric Cooperative (PANELCO I).

They are part of the NEA-PHILRECA-EC Task Force Kapatid, a special unit of technical workers strategically deployed by electric cooperative (EC) regional organizations in coordination with the NEA and PHILRECA to assist other ECs in the rehabilitation of facilities damaged by calamities.

Three ECs from the Central Luzon Electric Cooperatives Association, Inc. (CLECA) sent a total of 20 lineworkers to Pangasinan to help restore power following the devastation of typhoon 'Emong' and the southwest monsoon.

On Monday, 28 July 2025, the Zambales I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ZAMECO I) deployed a contingent of 4 lineworkers; Zambales II Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ZAMECO II) sent 6 lineworkers; and Peninsula Electric Cooperative, Inc. (PENELCO) sent 10 lineworkers.

In support of their sister-EC in Region 1, Ilocos Norte Electric Cooperative, Inc. (INEC) also deployed a team of 7 lineworkers to PANELCO I on Sunday, 27 July 2025.

Pangasinan III Electric Cooperative (PANELCO III), Nueva Vizcaya Electric Cooperative (NUVELCO), and the other 11 CLECA members are on standby, ready to provide additional support.
